Thomas Fischer

Thomas is also a member of JGAM's Investment Committee, where he is responsible for the Foreign Exchange strategy. Thomas travels the world giving presentations about the markets and the investment opportunities at JGAM.

Gary Scott enjoys a worldwide reputation. Gary was one of the first publishers to suggest global investing. May 2009 was the 41st anniversary of his reporting on international investments. Gary is an entrepreneur, author and investment publisher, who began writing about multi currency portfolios four decades ago when many thought he was crazy. Finally decades later, the establishment is on the bandwagon. His international investment beginnings began when he spotted Hong Kong's emergence on his first trips there in the late 1960s.

He wrote a column for "The Global Guide", a newsletter published by one of Canada's top portfolio managers, appeared in federal court as an expert witness on international economics and managed a multi million dollar portfolio for one of Austria's leading international investment banks. Today he manages a multi currency investing course in a strategic alliance with JGAM owned by Jyske Bank, Denmark's second largest bank, and leading global asset manager.
