Lars Stouge



Lars Stouge holds an MSc in Economics, an Executive MBA and is an Authorized Broker-Dealer. Lars has worked in the financial sector since finishing his MSc in Economics in 1990. His dissertation was on the euro and was written while he was employed with the EU Commission during the preparations of the euro's introduction. As a student Lars also worked as an assistant teacher in economics and a research assistant.

Lars' first job as an economist and financial analyst was with a bankers association. He moved on to a position as Portfolio Manager with a bank before joining Jyske Bank as Chief Economist in 1996. In 2007 Lars was made responsible for developing and establishing Jyske Global Asset Management (JGAM), a subsidiary of the bank specialized in servicing US investment clients. Today Lars is the president of JGAM.

Lars has always been dedicated to education. In 2004 he completed an Executive MBA at the Scandinavian International Management Institute (SIMI). Furthermore, for nine years Lars was employed part time as an associate professor in finance at the second largest business school in Denmark. Lars is also a former member of the Money Market Committee and the Macro Economic Committee of the Danish Bankers Association. Today Lars is active as an Examiner for several business schools and used as an Accreditation Expert at the Danish Evaluation Institute; an institute responsible for certifying education programs in Denmark. Furthermore, Lars is a mentor at the SIMI Executive MBA Program and an Industry Advisor for SIMI Service Delivery Program.

Thomas Fischer



Thomas Fischer started in the trading room as a Foreign Exchange dealer in 1978, and for the next 22 years he spent all his working hours on the telephone trading currencies. During his trading career he spent two years in London and ten years in Germany where he was head of the international currency section of a major German broker company. During his time in Germany, Thomas successfully completed an MBA focusing on the external environment and corporate finance.

Gary Scott



Gary Scott enjoys a worldwide reputation. Gary was one of the first publishers to suggest global investing. May 2008 is the 40th anniversary of his reporting on international investments. Gary is an entrepreneur, author and investment publisher who began writing about multi currency portfolios four decades ago when many thought he was crazy. Finally decades later, the establishment is on the bandwagon.

His international investment beginnings began when he spotted Hong Kong's emergence on his first trips there in the late 1960s.

Gary has appeared on numerous TV and radio shows and was heard weekly for years on the syndicated radio program, Market Rap, which was broadcast by WEVD in New York City. He was a monthly columnist for, "On Wall Street", one of the largest circulation magazines for US stock brokers under the bi line "The Global Guru". He wrote a column for "The Global Guide", a newsletter published by one of Canada's top portfolio managers, appeared in federal court as an expert witness regarding international economics and managed a multi million dollar portfolio for one of Austria's leading international investment banks. Today he manages a multi currency investing course in a strategic alliance with JGAM owned by Jyske Bank, Denmark's second largest bank and leading global asset manager.

John Mauldin



John Mauldin is a Fort Worth, Texas businessman, now living in Uptown Dallas, and the father of seven children, ranging from ages 13 through 30, five of whom are adopted.

He was Chief Executive Officer of the American Bureau of Economic Research, Inc., a publisher of newsletters and books on various investment topics, from 1982 to 1987. He was one of the founders of Adopting Children Together Inc., the largest adoption support group in Texas. He currently serves on the board of directors of The International Reconciliation Coalition and the International Children's Relief Fund. He is also a member of the Knights of Malta, and has served on the Executive Committee of the Republican Party of Texas.

Samuel Rachlin



Samuel Rachlin One of Denmark's most recognizable on-air personalities combines his work as a Communications and PR Consultant with his activities as a columnist, writer, and lecturer. He lives and works in Washington DC.

Most recently he worked as the Executive Director of Corporate Communications for Saxo Bank, a Copenhagen based on-line investment Bank.

Prior to that, Rachlin worked for Danish TV2 as the anchor of the Finance and Business news. As a pioneer of the network, he participated in building its news department and later served as the network's first anchorman of the evening news. He subsequently became the station's first Washington correspondent. Similarly, he was the first Moscow Correspondent for Denmark's other network, DR, from 1977 to 1984.

Rachlin has also worked as spokesman and media advisor at the Washington D.C. headquarters of the World Bank from 1995-1998 before returning to TV2 as the network's Moscow correspondent. In addition to his lengthy roster of television credits, Rachlin has worked broadly as a financial and foreign affairs columnist for business daily Børsen, national daily Jyllands-Posten, Danish weekly Mandag Morgen, and as foreign editor of Børsens Nyhedsmagasin, a business magazine. In recent years, he has published some of his columns in The International Herald Tribune.

A graduate of Copenhagen University and the Columbia University Graduate School of Journalism, Rachlin is also a Nieman Fellow at Harvard University. He is the recipient of Columbia University's Alumni Award for Excellence in Journalism.

Steve Blumenthal

Brandon Hall



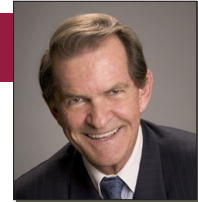
Brandon Hall is a partner and Director of Operation for Entrust Freedom, LLC a Third-Party Administrator for self-directed IRAs and Retirement plans.
